Clayton County District Attorney Tasha M. Mosley announces the conviction of Clifford Alexander Pink. The defendant was found guilty by a Clayton County jury of Aggravated Assault.

During the trial, the State presented evidence showing that on October 28, 2023, Mr. Pink got into a verbal altercation with his nephew over clothing. After yelling repeated derogatory insults toward his nephew, Mr. Pink produced a machete. He then struck his nephew in the head with the machete, causing a large, deep laceration. His nephew was able to escape and lock himself in his room.

The case was prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Travis McDowell and Assistant District Attorney Kyle Gifford. Victim Advocates Kenya Shepard and Maria Dillard, as well as Investigator Johnathan Miller, played crucial roles in the prosecution of this case.

Clayton County Superior Court Judge Robert Mack presided over this case and sentenced Mr. Pink to a total of 10 years with 7 years to serve in prison.

District Attorney Mosley stated, "This outcome reflects our unwavering dedication to justice and holding offenders accountable."
