Clayton County District Attorney Tasha M. Mosley announces the conviction of James R. Brown for the offenses of Felony Murder, Aggravated Assault, Aggravated Battery, and Possession of a Firearm During the Commission of a Felony.

Deputy Chief Assistant District Attorney Jennifer Brooks led the State's case with Assistant District Attorney Jill Hartsfield serving as second chair. Major Case Investigator Chad Watkins and Victim Advocate Nerissa Sims played vital roles in this case.

Senior Judge Arch W. McGarity presided over the trial which began on November 11, 2024. The Defendant was found guilty on November 15, 2024, and received a sentence of life in prison without the possibility of parole plus 5 years to serve in custody.

District Attorney Mosley stated, "Due to the involvement of a co-defendant in this case, additional details cannot be disclosed at this time and we hope this conviction provides a sense of justice and closure to Mr. Brown's family."
